O.LL-II 28/2000 14594/L . In exercise of the power conferred by section 38 of the Orissa shops and Commercial Establishments Act 1956 (Orissa Act 30 of 1956), The State Government do hereby direct that every employer shall display the name and address of the shop of the commercial establishment, as the case may be prominently by way of sign Board or other means in front of such shop or establishment written in Oriya language and maintain all registers and records as required to be maintained and display the notices as required to be displayed in Oriya language under the provisions of the Rules.

Provided that nothing herein debars the employer to use any other language in addition to Oriya.
